WHEREAS, the California State University ("CSU") conducted a Request for Proposals (RFP) for a Systemwide Job Order Contract System, and selected The Gordian Group, Inc. dba The Mellon Group as the highest-ranking proposer, and has entered into a contract with The Gordian Group, Inc. dba The Mellon Group for a Systemwide Job Order Contract System pursuant to CSU Contract Number 80246 ("CSU Contract"); and

WHEREAS, the City's participation in the CSU Contract will facilitate expeditious completion of a Systemwide Job Order Contract System as well as provide
