MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

BETWEEN THE LONG BEACH K-9 OFFICERS ASSOCIATION AND THE CITY OF LONG BEACH POLICE DEPARTMENT RELATED TO DONATION OF K-9

THIS MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING (hereinafter "MOU") is entered as of November 24, 2020, for reference purposes only, by and between THE CITY OF LONG BEACH, CALIFORNIA, a municipal corporation, through the LONG BEACH POLICE DEPARTMENT, (hereinafter "CITY") and the LONG BEACH K-9 OFFICERS ASSOCIATION (hereinafter "ASSOCIATION").

WHEREAS, since the inception of CITY's Police Service Dog Unit, the ASSOCIATION has purchased and provided all police service dogs (hereinafter "K-9") for use by the CITY; and

WHEREAS, historically, ASSOCIATION has also been providing funding for off-duty veterinary care for K-9, as well as food and certain equipment for the K-9s; and

WHEREAS, when a K-9 reaches the end of its service life and retires, ASSOCIATION has also provided post-retirement veterinary care and food for K-9s; and

WHEREAS, CITY and ASSOCIATION seek to memorialize that such care, purchases and transfers of K-9 by ASSOCIATION to CITY shall be deemed a donation, and CITY shall be deemed to have ownership of the K-9s; and

WHEREAS, the purpose of this MOU is to establish that funding for off-duty medical care, food, and certain equipment provided by ASSOCIATION to CITY, as well as ownership of all K-9s purchased and transferred, past, present and future, by ASSOCIATION to CITY, shall continue to be provided at no cost to CITY, and CITY shall release ASSOCIATION of any rights or obligations related to said K-9; and

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual terms and conditions herein, the CITY and ASSOCIATION agree as follows:

1. <u>RECITALS</u>. The recitals stated above are incorporated in the MOU by this reference.

3. <u>DONATION</u>. ASSOCIATION has donated and will continue to donate: K-9s to CITY for use by the Long Beach Police Service Dog Unit; funding for off-duty veterinary care as well as food for K-9s and post-retirement; and certain equipment to CITY for the K-9s. Satisfaction of any and all tax liabilities, whether City, County, State, or Federal arising from said donations and use shall be the sole responsibility of CITY.

Satisfaction of any tax liabilities arising from said donations and use shall be the sole responsibility of CITY and CITY shall hold harmless, indemnify, and defend ASSOCIATION from any and all liability arising from said tax liabilities.

4. OWNERSHIP AND USE. CITY shall be the sole owner of and have complete responsibility for any K-9 upon taking possession of said K-9, and such use shall be in compliance with all applicable federal, state and local laws, ordinances, and regulations. Upon a K-9's retirement and adoption by the handler or any other person, CITY shall ensure an Adoption Waiver and Release is signed by the adopter including the requirement that the adopter shall care for the K-9 in a humane and responsible manner and shall provide the K-9 with clean and adequate shelter, proper licensing, food, water,

27 28 and veterinary care to the extent it is not provided by ASSOCIATION.

- RELEASE. Upon the transfer of a K-9 by ASSOCIATION to CITY, CITY assumes all risk(s) associated with the possession, use, and deployment of the K-9 and hereby expressly releases and discharges ASSOCIATION from any and all liability, damages, claims, causes of action, losses, suits, proceedings cost and expenses arising from or connected with the donation of the said K-9 to the CITY, the use of the K-9s by any person after their transfer to CITY, or the condition, ownership or transfer of the K-9s.
- 6. WAIVER OF GENERAL RELEASE. CITY expressly waives the rights and benefits available to it under section 1542 of the California Civil Code which provides:

"A general release does not extend to claims which the creditor does not know or suspect to exist in his [or her] favor at the time of executing the release, which is known by him [or her] must have materially affected his [or her] settlement with the debtor."

7. **GENERAL PROVISIONS.**

- Α. This MOU shall be governed by and construed under the laws of the State of California.
- B. In the event suit is filed relating to any provision hereof, venue shall be in the Los Angeles County Superior Court.
- C. If any part of this MOU is declared by a Court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid or unenforceable, the remainder of its provisions shall remain in full force and effect.
- D. Nothing herein contained is intended to create a joint venture, partnership, principal-agent, master-servant or employer relationship between the parties.
- E. Any notice given hereunder shall be in writing and personally delivered or deposited in the United States Postal Service, postage prepaid, registered or certified mail, addressed to ASSOCIATION and CITY at the addresses provided in Section II hereof. Notice of change of address shall be given in the

same manner as stated herein for other notices. Notice shall be deemed given on the date personal delivery is made or on the date deposited in the United States Mail, whichever first occurs.

- This MOU constitutes the entire agreement between the parties F. regarding the subject matter hereof, and supersedes all prior discussions, understandings, or writings.
- G. Any amendment or modification hereof shall be in writing signed by both parties.
