Recommendation to increase appropriations in the Capital Projects Fund Group in the Public Works Department in the amount of \$2,500, offset by the Fifth Council District One-time District Priority Funds transferred from the General Fund Group in the Citywide Activities Department to support critical need safety improvements in the Fifth Council District;

Direct City Manager and all applicable departments to work with Los Angeles Department of Water and Power (LADWP) on options for installing an additional gate at the Spring Street Service Road to limit pedestrian and vehicle access to the land owned and operated by LADWP, formerly occupied by Jauregui Nursery ("Tree Farm"); and to coordinate additional "No Trespassing" signage that would give legal authority to Long Beach Police Department to access the property and enforce any reported illegal activity occurring in the property.
