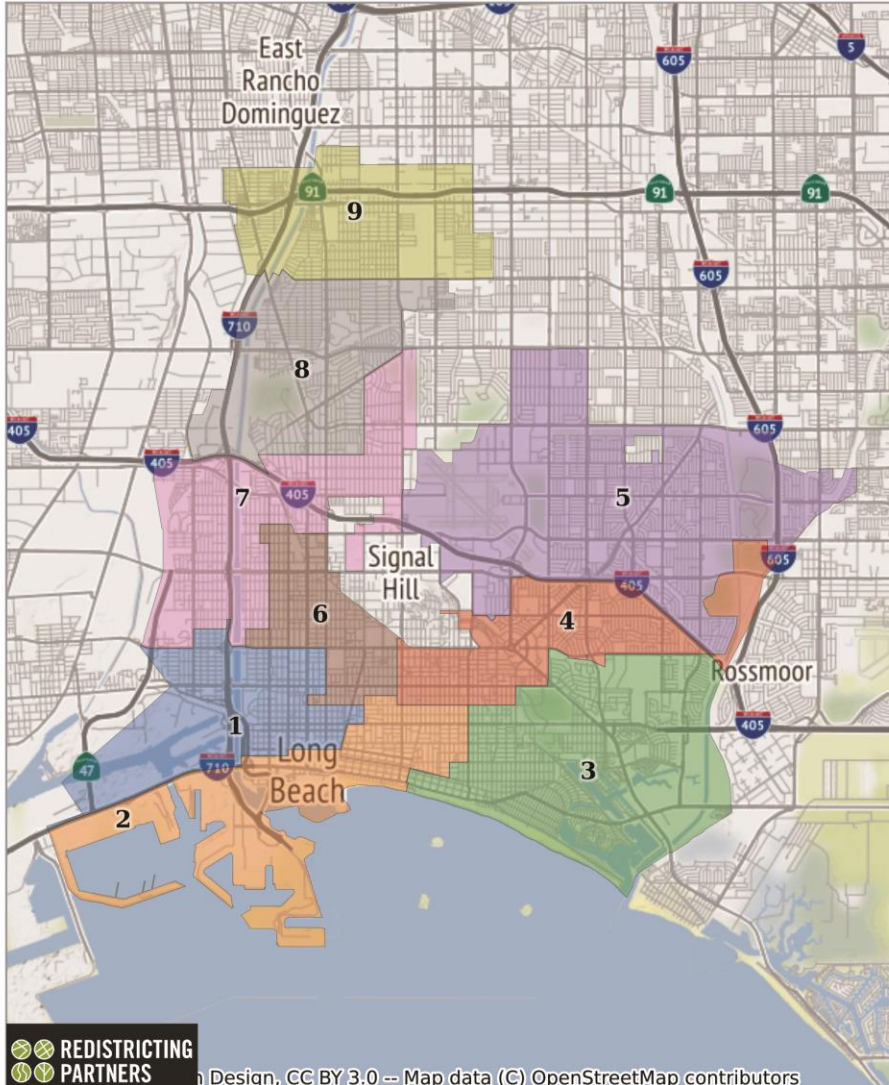

Upcoming: Additional Data Sources

In addition to these census data, we can expand to other data sources in order to illustrate known communities and where they geographically lie within the city. Some examples are:

- Voter file identified ethnic subgroups – surname matching and voter-provided birthplace information to identify ethnicities.
- LGBTQ characteristics from state data, LGBT Organizations and algorithms against voter registration data.
- Environmental data like noise and pollution mapping.
- Student data, including student housing and off-campus living.
