
BACKGROUND

- Craftsman Architectural Style
- Lot Size: 6,750 S.F.
- Zone: R-2-A (Two-Family Residential, Accessory Second Unit)
- Bluff Heights Historic Dist. Contributing Structure

PROJECT SCOPE

Demolish an existing 240-square-foot one-car garage

 Construct a new one-story, detached, 771-square-foot structure consisting of:


A 388-square-foot accessory dwelling unit (ADU); and

 A 383-square-foot two-car garage at the rear half of the property.











PROPOSED SITE PLAN







PROPOSED GARAGE/ADU FLOOR PLAN






Proposed South Elevation (Side)




Proposed North Elevation (Side)

FINDINGS

As proposed, the 771 S.F. garage/ADU structure is:

- 1. In compliance with the Zoning Code;
- 2. Bluff Height Historic District Design Guidelines;
- 3. Secretary of Interior's Standards;
- 4. Ordinance No. C-7937 Bluff Heights Historic District;
- 5. Craftsman Style Guide
- 6. Certificate of Appropriateness Findings.





RECOMMENDATION

Staff recommends approval of the Certificate of Appropriateness request for the demolition of an existing 240-square-foot one-car garage and construction of a new one-story, detached, 771-square-foot structure consisting of a 388-square-foot accessory dwelling unit (ADU) and 383-square-foot two-car garage at the rear half of the property. This property is located at 279 Molino Avenue and is a contributing structure in the Bluff Heights Historic District. (District 2)
