SUBJECT: Fiscal Year 2022 Action Plan Development (Citywide)

RECOMMENDATION:

Receive and file the presentation and accept public input on the development of the 2021- 2022 Annual Action Plan.

DISCUSSION

The U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) requires the City to develop and submit a Five-Year Consolidated Plan (Consolidated Plan) and an annual Action Plan (AP) that furthers the goals established in the Consolidated Plan for use of Community Development Block Grant (CDBG), Home Investment Partnership Grant (HOME), and Emergency Solution Grant (ESG) funds. The current Consolidated Plan was approved by the City Council and HUD in 2017, and is valid from October 1, 2017, through September 30, 2022.

As part of the entitlement submittal to HUD the City, in conjunction with The Long Beach Community Investment Company (LBCIC), will develop a Fiscal Year 2022 (FY22) AP. The FY22 AP will describe the resources, programs, and activities the City will undertake in the fourth year of the Consolidated Plan period to address the needs and implement the programs identified in the Consolidated Plan. The Consolidated Plan provides the parameters for developing the proposed FY22 AP budget.

The City's Fiscal Year 2020 (FY20) Consolidated Annual Performance Evaluation Report (CAPER), the third CAPER under the current Consolidated Plan, describes the progress made towards achieving the housing and community development goals identified in the City's Consolidated Plan and the FY20 AP. The CAPER, was submitted to HUD and the public for review on the required due date of January 31, 2021. The FY 21 AP for the current Consolidated Plan is underway and accomplishments will be evaluated through the submission of the CAPER to HUD and the public.

At the April 21, 2021 meeting, the LBCIC will conduct the first Public Hearing to establish the basis for developing the FY22 AP by assessing accomplishments to date towards current Consolidated Plan goals for HUD grants as well as receiving public input.
