

ORDINANCE NO. ORD-10-0010

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE  
CITY OF LONG BEACH AMENDING THE LONG BEACH  
MUNICIPAL CODE BY ADDING SUBSECTION II TO  
SECTION 10.22.080 RELATING TO PARKING VEHICLES  
FOR SALE

WHEREAS, the City has received numerous complaints from citizens  
regarding the parking of vehicles with "For Sale" signs on both sides of Artesia Boulevard  
between Atlantic Avenue and Orange Avenue; between Orange Avenue and Cherry  
Avenue; and between Cherry Avenue and Paramount Boulevard; and

WHEREAS, with the increase of vehicles parking with "For Sale" signs on  
them in the areas described above, such activity is creating unsafe traffic conditions  
because motorists interrupt traffic flow to stop or slow down to observe the vehicles  
displaying "For Sale" signs which creates the potential for traffic collisions;

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Long Beach ordains as  
follows:

Section 1. Section 10.22.080 of the Long Beach Municipal Code is  
hereby amended by adding Subsection II to read as follows:

II. Both sides of Artesia Boulevard between Atlantic Avenue and  
Orange Avenue; between Orange Avenue and Cherry Avenue; and  
between Cherry Avenue and Paramount Boulevard.

Section 2. The City Clerk shall certify to the passage of this ordinance by  
the City Council and cause it to be posted in three (3) conspicuous places in the City of  
Long Beach, and it shall take effect on the thirty-first (31st) day after it is approved by the

Mayor.


