A RESOLUTION OF INTENTION TO VACATE THE PEDESTRIAN WALK BETWEEN JANICE DRIVE AND HARDING STREET, EAST OF ATLANTIC AVENUE, IN THE CITY OF LONG BEACH, COUNTY OF LOS ANGELES, STATE OF CALIFORNIA, PURSUANT TO THE PUBLIC STREET, **HIGHWAYS** AND SERVICE EASEMENTS LAW (DIVISION 9, PART 3, CALIFORNIA STREETS AND HIGHWAYS CODE); FIXING A TIME AND PLACE FOR HEARING ALL PERSONS INTERESTED IN OR OBJECTING TO THE PROPOSED VACATION

The City Council of the City of Long Beach resolves as follows:

The City Council of the City of Long Beach hereby elects to 15 Section 1. proceed under Division 9, Part 3, Chapter 3, of the California Streets and Highways Code 16 17 (Section 8320 et seq.), as amended, generally known and referred as the "Public Street, 18 Highways and Service Easements Law", and hereby declares its intention to vacate the 19 pedestrian walk between Janice Drive and Harding Street, east of Atlantic Avenue, in the 20 City of Long Beach, County of Los Angeles, State of California, described more 21 particularly as follows:

> That 10-foot wide public right-of-way labeled "WALK" in Tract No. 12769 in the City of Long Beach, County of Los Angeles, State of California, as shown on the map of said Tract filed in Book 246, Pages 37 and 38 of Maps in the Office of the County Recorder of said County, said walk lying adjacent to Lots 16, 17, 26 and 27 of said Tract, bounded on

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the north by the southerly line of Harding Street, 80 feet wide, and on the south by the northerly line of Janice Drive, 50 feet wide, both as shown on said Tract Map.

Section 2. All of the foregoing real property is shown on the map or plan
thereof, attached hereto as Exhibit "A", and on file in the office of the City Clerk, which
map or plan is known and referred to as "City of Long Beach Department of Public Works
Vacation Sketch No. 997V".

Section 3. The City Council hereby fixes the <u>3rd</u> day of <u>August</u>, 2010 at the hour of <u>5:00</u> p.m., as the time and the City Council Chamber, Plaza Level of the City Hall, 333 West Ocean Boulevard, in the City of Long Beach, California, as the place for hearing all persons interested in or objecting to the proposed vacation.

Section 4. The City Council hereby directs that notice of said hearing on this proposed street vacation be published for at least two (2) successive weeks prior to the hearing and in the manner provided by Section 8322 of the State Streets and Highways Code.

Section 5. The City Council hereby directs that notice of this street
vacation be posted conspicuously along the street proposed to be vacated at least two
(2) weeks before the date set for hearing and in the manner provided by Section 8323 of
the State Streets and Highways Code.

22 Section 6. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption 23 by the City Council, and the City Clerk shall certify to the vote adopting this resolution.


