A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LONG BEACH AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT WITH FULGENT GENETICS, INC. TO PROVIDE COVID-19 SERVICES THROUGH ITS CONTRACT WITH ST. CHARLES COUNTY OF MISSOURI, IN AN ANNUAL AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$19,887,000

WHEREAS, the Charter of the City of Long Beach (the "City"), Section 1802, permits the City to purchase services, supplies, materials, equipment and labor with other government agencies by purchasing under their contracts on a voluntary and selective basis when authorized by resolution; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to purchase COVID-19 appointment scheduling, testing and insurance billing services; and

WHEREAS, FULGENT GENETICS, INC. ("FULGENT") has a contract with St. Charles County, Missouri, for the purchase of these COVID-19 services ("Contract"); and

WHEREAS, the City's participation in the Contract will facilitate the City's ability to purchase COVID-19 services as well as provide considerable cost benefits to the City; and

WHEREAS, if the City had to utilize a formal bid process rather than participate in the COVID-19 services Contract, considerably more funds would be required;

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Long Beach resolves as follows:

Section 1. The above recitals are true and correct and are incorporated

herein by this reference.

Section 2. The City Manager or designee is hereby authorized to enter an agreement with FULGENT to purchase COVID-19 services, of the same type and kind identified in the St. Charles County, Missouri, Contract, except as modified by mutual agreement of the City and FULGENT, and the purchase by the City shall be on the same terms and conditions afforded to St. Charles County, Missouri, unless mutually modified. in an annual amount not to exceed Nineteen Million Eight Hundred Eighty-Seven Thousand Dollars (\$19,887,000), including tax and shipping, with the option to renew so long as the St. Charles County contract is in effect, at the discretion of the City Manager.

Section 3. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption by the City Council, and the City Clerk shall certify the vote adopting this resolution.
