But we are going to have a map tool training from Redistricting Partners so they can show us, how you can show us, your Community of Interest".

The first mapping software is one we've presented several times as a training video on the website, so I might make a more cursory overview of this mapping tool then get a little bit more into a new mapping tool that we also going to have available.

Maptitude Online for Redistricting is a program used throughout the country, one of those prominent mapping tools that is available for public engagement".

It is really intended primarily as a used tool for drawing districts, but you can also use it to draw communities of interests."

TIMESTAMP 33:10 Paul Mitchell continues about Maptitude comments "And there, you can also submit the plan. When you submit the plan, that plan becomes a public document and it will be converted for the Commissioners into a PDF. It will be one of the items they consider when they go into the draft map hearings is all the public submission. So, submitting a plan with this button is the way to make sure that plan is going to get a kind of full airing."
