Adopt Specifications WD-15-19 for the North Long Beach Collection Main Control Valve Upgrade Project (EO-3435) and authorize the General Manager to sign a construction contract with Cora Constructors, Inc., in the amount of \$1,249,350.

Executive Summary

On August 10, 2021 and August 17, 2021, staff published the Notice of Inviting Bids for the North Long Beach Collection Main Control Valve Upgrade Project (EO-3435) as required by Public Contract Code Section 22037. This project is for the upgrade of a pressure transmitter and a butterfly valve along the North Long Beach collection main. The pressure transmitter is located in an existing vault south of the intersection of Cherry Avenue and Tehachapi Drive, and the new butterfly valve will be located in a new vault approximately 1,500 feet east of the intersection of Cherry Avenue and Wardlow Road. The work includes rehabilitation of the existing pressure transmitter vault, construction of a new vault for the new butterfly valve, upgrade of existing pressure transmitter and control valve appurtenances, and four different condition assessments of the collection main.

On September 20, 2021, five (5) bids were received and opened. The bid tabulation is attached. After evaluating all bids received, the lowest responsive bid submitted by Cora Constructors, Inc., in the amount of \$1,249,350 was found to be in conformance with the bid documents.

The Engineer's estimate is \$1,116,000.

Recommendation

Adopt Specifications WD-15-19 for the North Long Beach Collection Main Control Valve Upgrade Project (EO-3435) and authorize the General Manager to sign a construction contract with Cora Constructors, Inc., in the amount of \$1,249,350.

Fiscal Impact: The cost to the Water Fund will be incurred during FY 22 with the annual amount being the contract total of \$1,249,350. The costs are included in the Water Fund FY 22 CIP budget.
