A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE
CITY OF LONG BEACH AUTHORIZING THE CITY
MANAGER TO EXECUTE A CONTRACT WITH PRIME
GOVERNMENT SOLUTIONS FOR THE IMPLEMENTATION
OF A LEGISLATIVE MANAGEMENT SYSTEM, ON THE
SAME TERMS AND CONDITIONS AFFORDED TO THE
CITY OF LOS ANGELES, IN AN AMOUNT OF \$129,404,
PLUS A 15 PERCENT CONTINGENCY IN THE AMOUNT OF
\$19,411, FOR A TOTAL AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED
\$148,815 FOR THE FIRST YEAR; THEREAFTER, IN AN
ANNUAL AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$69,830, WITH
ANNUAL INCREASES UP TO 5 PERCENT, UNTIL THE
CITY OF LOS ANGELES CONTRACT EXPIRES ON JULY
31, 2023, WITH THE OPTION TO RENEW FOR AS LONG
AS THE CITY OF LOS ANGELES CONTRACT IS IN EFFECT

WHEREAS, the Charter of the City of Long Beach, Section 1802, permits the City Manager to enter into a contract on behalf of the City, in writing or otherwise, without advertising for bids, for services, supplies, materials, equipment or labor, with other government agencies, when authorized by resolution; and

WHEREAS, the City requires a new legislative management system; and WHEREAS, Prime Government Solutions has a contract with the City of Los Angeles, California, for the provision and implementation of a new, integrated, automated and user friendly legislative management system, Contract No. C-136426 ("LA Contract"); and

WHEREAS, the City's participation in the LA Contract will facilitate

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acquisition of a new legislative management system as well as provide considerable cost benefits to the City; and

WHEREAS, if the City had to go to formal bid rather than participate in the LA Contract considerably more funds would be required;

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Long Beach resolves as follows:

Section 1. The City Manager or designee is hereby authorized to enter a contract with Prime Government Solutions for a new legislative management system, in an amount of One Hundred Twenty-Nine Thousand Four Hundred Four Dollars (\$129,404), plus a fifteen percent (15%) contingency in the amount of Nineteen Thousand Four Hundred Eleven Dollars (\$19.411), for a total amount not to exceed One Hundred Forty-Eight Thousand Eight Hundred Fifteen Dollars (\$148.815) for the first year; thereafter, in an annual amount not to exceed Sixty-Nine Thousand Eight Hundred Thirty Dollars (\$69,830), with annual increases up to five percent (5%), until the City of Los Angeles contract expires on July 31, 2023, with the option to renew, for as long as the City of Los Angeles contract is in effect, at the discretion of the City Manager.

Section 2. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption by the City Council, and the City Clerk shall certify the vote adopting this resolution.
