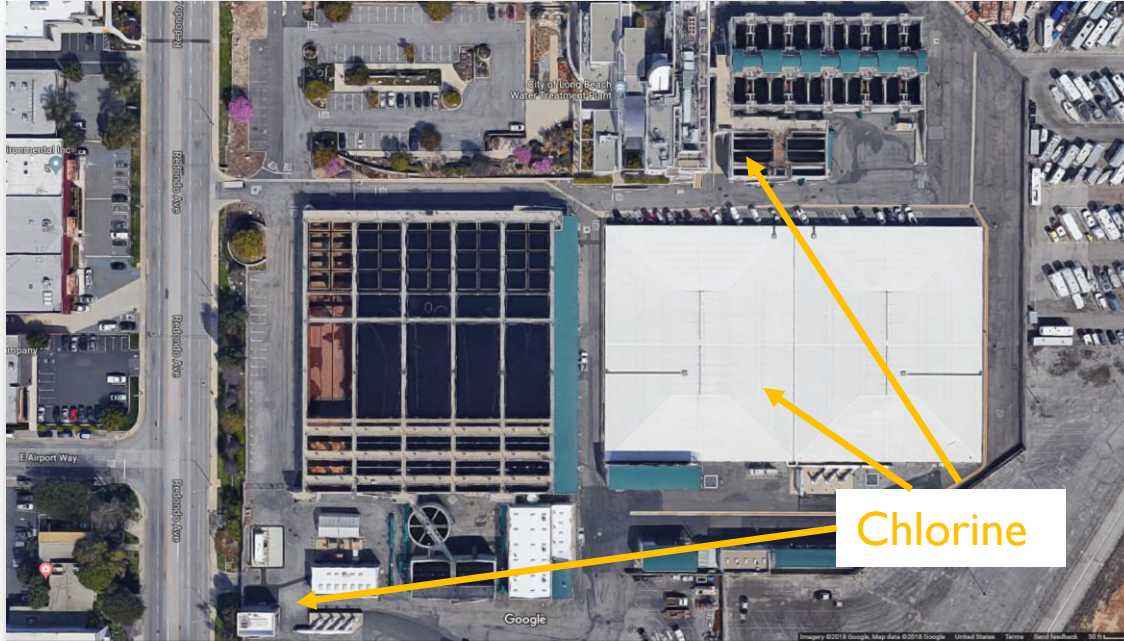

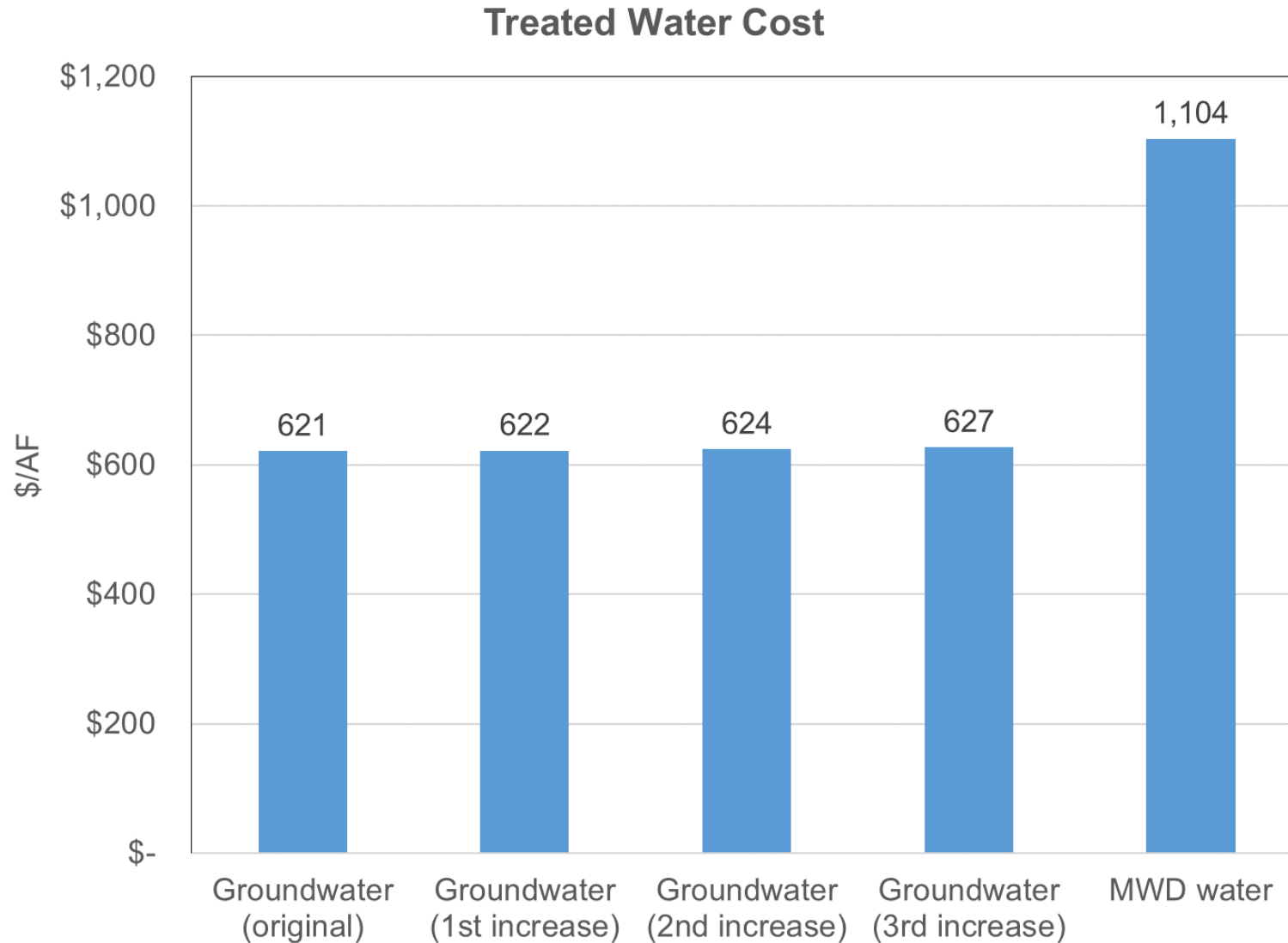
Use of Chlorine at GWTP



- Chlorine protects public health and achieve regulatory compliance
 - Disinfect microbes within the plant
 - Maintain a chlorine residual to the consumers' tap
 - Comply with regulation requirement

Recommendation and Next Steps

- Recommendation
 - Authorize the General Manager to amend the existing agreement with JCI Jones Chemicals Inc., to furnish and deliver liquid chlorine, increasing the contract amount by \$50,000 for a total amount not to exceed \$375,000 for the remaining contract year.
- Next Steps
 - Go out to bid for all chemical contracts and seek board approval
 - Work with other utilities and water associations to seek possible long term solutions
