City staff spoke about potential November 18, 2014 parking meter Council discussion.

Rossi asked if the Commission would consider adding two more Big Belly trash compactors on 2nd Street.

Jeffer spoke about recommending agendizing new Big Belly trash compactors to Chair Lorbeer.

Schneiter asked if the Big Belly trash compactors have proven beneficial.

Rossi spoke about the benefits of the Big Belly trash compactors.

Alavi spoke about cleaning the parking lot behind Super Mex.

Rossi spoke about the Super Mex parking lot ownership, and that efforts are under way by the

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owner to clean the area an maintaining it as well.
