EXECUTIVE STAFF REPORTS

2. <u>22-038BH</u> Recommendation to receive and file a report from the Director of Health and Human Services.

Kelly Colopy, Director of Health and Human Services, provided the following information to the Board:

• The Health Department received a \$3.9 million grant award from the California Violence Prevention Intervention Grant Program to expand violence prevention activities to reduce gun violence and deaths.

• The State budget include \$200 million for local public health jurisdictions to support public health workforce and infrastructure. It is estimated Long Beach HHS will receive approximately \$2.8 million to support local public health efforts.

• The State budget recommendation includes the Public Health HEROES funding, which will provide one-time funding for workforce retention and training. The mechanism for distributing these funds is still unknown.

• Ongoing work the Department is undertaking to assist families with infants during the formula shortage.

• Ongoing conversations regarding street vending/food carts and food safety. A Council study session on this subject is scheduled for July 12, 2022.

Dr. Anissa Davis, City Health Officer, provided the following information to the Board:

• A current Monkeypox outbreak affecting over 1,000 individuals in 46 countries to date.

• As part of the City's HIV/STD Strategy, in partnership with AltaMed, Positive Prevention plus Sex Health Education was provided to 2,899 students in the Long Beach Unified School District.

• Working on a needs assessment to gather information about community awareness and knowledge of sexual health resources in Long Beach.

• Revamping the Department's Veterinary Public Health Programming and partnering with Los Angeles County.

• The 2020 Communicable Disease Annual Report will be released later today.
