Recommendation to request City Manager to review issues associated with parking impacts to neighborhoods adjoining the Deukmejian Courthouse, including but not limited to the areas bordered by Broadway to the South, 4th Street to the North, Cedar Avenue to the East and Golden Avenue to the West. Upon its completion in 2013, the Governor George Deukmejian Courthouse was estimated to house approximately 500 staff members including bench and court staff, Sheriff's staff and other county employees and serve an estimated 5,000 individuals on a daily basis.

This outside influx of new people in the West Gateway Neighborhood has created an even greater impact on residential parking than existed prior to the relocation of the courthouse.
