Recommendation to receive and approve changes to the Conflict of Interest Code of the Long Beach Oil Properties Department.

The City of Long Beach Oil Properties Department has adopted and forwarded for review a change in its Conflict of Interest Code. Two new titles have been added to the departments Schedule "A" due to recent reorganization.

The City Council is the code reviewing body for all departments and advisory bodies, commissions and committees that have previously adopted conflict of interest codes. Government Code Section 87306 provides that agencies shall amend its Conflict of Interest Code when change is necessitated by circumstances, including the creation of new positions, which must be designated pursuant to subdivision (a) of Government Code Section 87302. The proposed revision of Schedule "A" has been reviewed and approved by Heather A. Mahood, Chief Assistant City Attorney.
