We are in receipt of an application from Mary L. Johnston for a widow's pension. Bruce F. Johnston, who died on or about the 26th day of June, 2021, was a retired Police Lieutenant in the Long Beach Police Department, having retired from active duty on July 1, 1991. Mrs. Johnston has filed an application for a widow's pension under the provisions of Subsection (4) of Section 187 of the Charter of the City of Long Beach prior to its repeal.
