This recommendation requests the City Manager to provide a contribution to Rancho Los Cerritos Foundation for their 2022 Gala. The total appropriation increase of \$1,000 in the General Fund Group in the City Manager Department will be offset by a decrease of appropriation of Third Council District One-Time District Priority Funds in the General Fund Group in the Citywide Activities Department. This recommendation is anticipated to require a minimal level of staff hours beyond normal budgeted scope of duties and have a minimal impact on City Council priorities. There is no local job impact associated with this item.
