This matter has been reviewed by Budget Analyst Joe R. Guerrero on August 25, 2023.

This recommendation requests the City Manager to provide a contribution to Latinos in Action to support their annual fundraiser as written above. The total appropriation increase of \$1,000 in the General Fund Group in the City Manager Department will be offset by a decrease of appropriation of Seventh Council District One-time District Priority funds in the General Fund Group in the Citywide Activities Department.
