Recommendation to increase appropriations in the General Fund Group in the City Manager Department by \$3,000, offset by the First Council District One-Time District Priority Funds, transferred from the Citywide Activities Department, to provide a donation to the following:

Houghton Park neighborhood with music and community presence in addition to attracting thousands of visitors each year. It is appropriate for City Council to support a funds transfer for the Uptown Jazz Festival.

STATEMENT OF URGENCY:

This item requires urgency so as to allow a timely transfer of funds.

This recommendation requests the City Manager to provide a contribution to Willmore City Heritage Association, in support of the 2023 SLAM event, in the amount of \$1000 and a contribution to support the Uptown Jazz Festival, in the amount of \$2,000. The total appropriation increase of \$3,000 in the General Fund Group in the City Manager Department will be offset by a decrease of appropriation of First Council District One-time District Priority Funds in the General Fund Group in the Citywide Activities Department. The requested action is anticipated to require a minimal level of staff hours beyond the normal budgeted scope of duties and expected to have minimal impact on existing City Council priorities.
