Recommendation to receive and file the application of JB Station, Incorporated, dba unknown, for an original Alcoholic Beverage Control License, at 601 West Willow Street, determine that the application serves the public convenience and necessity, submit a Public Notice of Protest to ABC, and direct City Manager to withdraw the protest if a Conditional Use Permit is granted. It is City Council policy to review applications for Alcoholic Beverage Control licenses to determine if a basis for protest against the issuance of the license exists. The attached application lists the possible bases for protest.

The Department of Alcoholic Beverage Control (ABC) received the above application on August 21, 2013. The applicant is still in the planning stage, and has not yet received a Conditional Use Permit (CUP). City Council response is due to ABC by October 10, 2013. Provided the Planning Commission approves the CUP, the recommendation includes a request to direct the City Manager to withdraw the Public Notice of Protest.
