This matter was reviewed by Budget Manager Grace H. Yoon on May 13, 2022.

This recommendation requests the City Manager Department to provide a contribution to Friends of Belmont Shore for their community concert scheduled for August 4, 2022. The total appropriation increase of \$621 in the General Fund Group in the City Manager Department will be offset by a decrease of appropriation of the Third Council District One-Time District Priority Funds in the General Fund Group in the Citywide Activities Department. The requested action is anticipated to require a minimal level of staff hours beyond the normal budgeted scope of duties and expected to have minimal impact on existing City Council

priorities. There is no local job impact associated with the recommendation.
