Title: Recommendation to request City Attorney to draft a citywide ordinance restricting oversized and

recreational vehicles in residential and commercial corridors based on elements from the surrounding

cities of Lakewood, Costa Mesa and Westminister like:

No RV shall be parked on any street or alley for more than 48

consecutive hours.

 RVs and trailers not registered to a Long Beach address cannot park on streets without a daily temporary permit.

 RVs registered to a Long Beach address may park on the block they are registered to for no more than 48 hours consecutively.

• RVs may not be repark within one fifth of a mile from any prior

permitted location within 24 hours.

• Nonmotorized vehicles may be parked for the sole purpose of actively loading and unloading for a no more than 24 hours.
