Title: Recommendation to adopt Specifications No. ITB FS22-052 and award contracts to Battery Systems,

Inc., of Long Beach, CA, H & H Auto Parts Wholesale., of Pacoima, CA, Hanson Distributing

Company, Inc., of Azusa, CA, Hubb Filters, Inc., of Albany, OR, Los Angeles Truck Centers, LLC, of Whittier, CA, Parts Authority, LLC, of Lake Success, NY, and SoCal Auto & Truck Parts, Inc., of Long Beach, CA, for purchase and delivery of general automotive parts, in an annual aggregate amount of \$1,500,000, with a 15 percent annual contingency amount of \$225,000, for a total annual aggregate amount not to exceed \$1,725,000 for a period of two years, with the option to renew for three additional one-year periods, at the discretion of the City Manager; and, authorize City Manager, or designee, to execute all documents necessary to enter into the contracts, including any necessary

subsequent amendments; and

Increase appropriation in the Fleet Services Fund Group in the Financial Management Department by \$400,000, offset by funds available generated by revenue collected from user departments through

the Fleet Memorandum of Understanding (MOU). (Citywide)
