Recommendation to request City Attorney to prepare amendments to Long Beach Municipal Code Sections 2.01.380 and 2.01.1020, relating to Officeholder accounts. (Citywide)

At its meeting of September 5, 2014, the Elections Oversight Committee heard the recommendations of the City Attorney to make certain amendments to the Long Beach Municipal Code, Long Beach Campaign Reform Act and Campaign Disclosure statements. The committee was able to ask questions and give the City Attorney clear direction in bringing our elections codes up to date.
