Recommendation to authorize City Manager, or designee, to execute a Public Walkways Occupancy Permit for sidewalk dining at Chipotle Mexican Grill, located at 245 Pine Ave, Suite No.190. (District 2)

The operator of Chipotle Mexican Grill, located at 245 Pine Ave, Suite No. 190, requests a permit to temporarily occupy part of the adjoining sidewalk for the purpose of sidewalk dining. The proposed permit area and the list of furnishings to be placed in the permit area are shown on Exhibit A. Approval of this permit is based on the conditions and standards of Chapter 14.14 of the Long Beach Municipal Code, which describes temporary uses of public right-of-way.

The width of the sidewalk at this location is 16 feet. A minimum clearance of 6 feet 6 inches will be maintained along the sidewalk adjacent to the permit area to provide for acceptable sidewalk clearance.

This matter was approved by the Department of Development Services Building and Safety Bureau on November 21, 2017, and by Deputy City Attorney Linda T. Vu and Budget Analysis Officer Julissa José-Murray on November 7, 2017.

City Council action on this matter is not time critical.

A permit processing fee of \$643 was deposited in the General Fund (GF) in the Public Works Department (PW), and a security deposit of \$605 was collected to ensure sidewalk repairs upon permit termination. Approval of this recommendation will provide continued support to the local economy.
