On March 17,2009, the City Council adopted a minute order pursuant to an agenda request which initiated a moratorium against smoking lounges in the City. The Ordinance, which has been prepared for Council's consideration, establishes a one (1) year moratorium period. During this time, the Development Services Department and the Planning Commission will undertake a study on the propriety of amending the City's Zoning Regulations, Building Regulations and pertinent Municipal Code provisions related to smoking lounges. The one (1) year moratorium will apply to any application received by the Development Services Department after March 17, 2009.
