The Belmont Shore Business Association will coordinate filming this event on December 1, 2018 to be aired later. The filming will help bring awareness to the businesses in the Shore and provide the community with the sense of holiday spirit to boost commerce for the area since the parade draws attention to so many residents in and around Long Beach.

The total appropriation increase of \$2,500 in the General Fund (GF) in the Legislative Department (LD) is offset by a decrease of appropriation of one-time District Priority Funds in the General Fund (GF) in the Citywide Activities Department (XC).
