In accordance with the City's "Procedures for Implementation of Divide by Nine Funding," the Sixth Council District is requesting that its one-time District Priority funds be transferred to the Special Events Office in the City Manager Department to cover expenses for the 2019 Martin Luther King Junior Celebration event.

The total appropriation increase of \$50,000 in the General Fund (GF) in the City Manager Department (CM) is offset by a decrease of appropriation of one-time District Priority Funds in the General Fund (GF) in the Citywide Activities Department (XC).
