Recommendation to receive the application of Pech Heng, dba Legend Seafood Restaurant, for a premise to premise and person to person transfer of an Alcoholic Beverage Control (ABC) License, at 1350 East Anaheim Street, submit a Public Notice of Protest to ABC, and direct City Manager to withdraw the protest if a Conditional Use Permit (CUP) is granted. It is City Council policy to review applications for ABC licenses to determine if a basis for protest against the issuance of the license exists. The attached application lists the possible bases for protest.

The Department of Alcoholic Beverage Control received the above application on February 19, 2019. The applicant is still in the planning stages, and has not yet received a CUP. Provided the Planning Commission approves the CUP, the recommendation includes a request to direct the City Manager to withdraw the Public Notice of Protest. City Council action is requested on April 9, 2019, to respond to the Department of Alcoholic Beverage Control by the April 10, 2019 due date.

There is no fiscal impact associated with this recommendation.
