Title: Authorize the Director of Parks, Recreation and Marine to approve a new park amenity and to execute all documents necessary to issue a Right of Entry Permit with Adventures to Dreams Enrichment Inc., a non-profit public benefit corporation, to begin the pre-construction (i.e. planning and organization) for a youth and family educational garden at Drake Chavez Greenbelt for a period of three months from January 1, 2020 through March 31, 2020, or until a City Council approved Lease can be executed and;

Recommend to the City Manager the approval of a Lease with Adventures to Dreams Enrichment Inc., a non-profit public benefit corporation, for the use of approximately 0.23-acres of City-owned land within the Drake Chavez Greenbelt as a youth and family educational garden and farm produce stand, for a period of five years, from March 1, 2020 through February 28, 2025, with two, two-year renewal options, at the discretion of the City Manager, which meets a recreational need within the City.
