Title: Recommendation to adopt resolution authorizing City Manager, or designee, to execute a contract,

and any necessary amendments, with Dell Marketing L.P., of Round Rock, TX, for furnishing and delivering Microsoft product licenses and support services, on the same terms and conditions afforded to the County of Riverside, California, through the Licensing Solution Provider Agreement Number PSA-0001524 and Riverside County Master Microsoft Enterprise Agreement No. 8084445, in an amount not to exceed \$907,000 for the first year, plus a 20 percent contingency in the amount of \$181,400, for a total amount not to exceed \$1,088,400; an annual amount not to exceed \$1,209,000 for the second year, plus a 20 percent contingency in the amount of \$241,800, for a total amount not to exceed \$2,539,200, until the current contract expires on October 31, 2021, with the option to renew for as long as the County of Riverside contract is in effect, for an annual amount of \$1,522,000, with a 20 percent contingency of \$304,400, for a total amount not to exceed \$1,826,400, at the discretion of
