The first year of the contract runs through FY 20 and FY 21 and the cost to the Water Fund will be incurred with the actual annual amounts unknown at this time but the total amount will not exceed the contract total of \$275,000 with the authorized Change Order. This Change Order is unbudgeted in the Water Fund. However, it is expected that these costs can be absorbed within the Water Fund using projected savings within the Fund.
