This recommendation requests the City Manager to provide a donation of \$500 to Ashlee's Homeless Fund. The total appropriation increase of \$500 in the General Fund Group in the City Manager Department is offset by the Fourth Council District One-time District Priority Funds in the Citywide Activities Department. Implementing this recommendation is anticipated to result in a minimal impact to staff hours beyond normal budgeted scope of duties and is expected to have a minimal impact on existing City Council priorities.
