Recommendation to increase appropriations in the General Fund Group in the City Manager Department by \$500, offset by the Fourth Council District One-time District Priority Funds, transferred from the Citywide Activities Department to provide a donation to Tichenor Clinic for Children for the Sixth Annual Carnival and Resource Fair; and

Decrease appropriations in the General Fund Group in the Citywide Activities Department by \$500 to offset a transfer to the City Manager Department.

The Tichenor Clinic for Children will be hosting the 6th Annual Carnival & Resource Fair on June 5th. This donation will help provide take-home game & activities, food and other important community resources.

This matter has been reviewed by Budget Manager Grace H. Yoon on May 17, 2021.

This recommendation requests the City Manager to provide a contribution to the Tichenor Clinic for Children for the Sixth Annual Carnival and Resource Fair. The total appropriation increase of \$500 in the General Fund Group in the City Manager Department is offset by the Fourth Council District One-time District Priority Funds in the Citywide Activities Department. Implementing this recommendation is expected to have a minimal impact to staff hours beyond normal budgeted scope of duties and is expected to have a minimal impact on existing City Council priorities.
