Recommendation to authorize the General Manager to execute an agreement with DRP Engineering, Inc., to provide hydrogeological/ engineering design and construction management services for the Long Beach Water Department 2021 New Well Project (O-0750) to drill, develop, construct, and equip four (4) new municipal water wells (Camp Fire 1, Commission 23A, El Dorado 1, and Citizens 8A) and to destroy two (2) existing municipal water wells (Commission 23 and Citizens 8), in an amount not to exceed \$3,367,682.

The cost to the Water Fund will be included and incurred during FY 22 through FY 25 with the actual annual amounts unknown at this time, but the total amount will not exceed the contract total of \$3,367,682. These amounts are included in the FY 22 budget and financial projections through FY 25.
