This matter has been reviewed by Budget Analyst Joe R. Guerrero on November 28, 2022.

This recommendation requests the City Manager to provide a contribution to Kahlo Creative LCC in support of the 2022 Long Beach International Tamales Festival. The total appropriation increase of \$500 in the General Fund Group in the City Manager Department will be offset by a decrease of appropriation of First Council District One-time District Priority Funds in the General Fund Group in the Citywide Activities Department. The requested action is anticipated to require a minimal level of staff hours beyond the normal budgeted scope of duties and expected to have minimal impact on existing City Council priorities.
