Recommendation to receive and file the application of Weiland Brewery Restaurant 3 Incorporated, dba Weiland Brewery Restaurant, for an original Alcoholic Beverage Control License, at 4354 Atlantic Avenue, submit a Public Notice of Protest to ABC, and direct City Manager to withdraw the protest if a Conditional Use Permit is granted. (District 8)

It is City Council policy to review applications for Alcoholic Beverage Control licenses to determine if a basis for protest against the issuance of the license exists. The attached application lists the possible bases for protest.
