Recommendation to request City Attorney prepare an opinion by May 17, 2005, regarding the proposal to increase the City's existing requirements for campaign contribution reporting, specifically, that all contributions of \$1,000 or more on behalf of a ballot measure be reported within 24 hours; require that all political action committees file reports disclosing expenditures in pursuit of placing an initiative on the ballot in Long Beach; and any other items that may be transmitted to the City Attorney.

The Elections Oversight Committee, at its meeting held Monday, May 2,2005, considered the above subject.
