Subject: Statement of Economic Interest Form 700 Compliance Final Totals

This report is intended to provide the final totals for the City of Long Beach Statement of Economic Interest Form 700 (Form 700) filers for the 2022 cycle.

The final totals for the 2022 cycle ended at 99%. There was a total of 20 late filers who filed after the April 3, 2023 deadline and 13 filers were reported to the Fair Political Practice Commission (FPPC) for enforcement. The Commissioner appointing bodies, including the Mayor's office will also be notified of the non-compliant Commissioner filers.

The final compliance totals reported to FPPC the for the Commissioners, City Employees, and Elected Officials are as follows:
