Work and the workplace have gone through enormous changes between the mid-19th century and the late 20th century. A new traveling exhibition from the National Archives and Smithsonian Institution, *The Way We Worked*, features 86 photographs from the National Archives focusing on the history of work in America and documenting work clothing, locales, conditions and conflicts. The exhibition opens on March 8, as the kick off event for *Smithsonian Week in Long Beach* and extends through May 17.

The Way We Worked exhibition was originally on view at the Lawrence F. O'Brien Gallery at the National Archives Building in Washington, D.C. and is now traveling to 13 cities in the United States through 2010. This is the only California venue to date.
