

MISSION

The 33rd Senate District Young Senators program is designed to provide high school students with unique opportunities that yield insights about potential career and educational paths. The Young Senators program is focused on exploring the industries, professions, and social innovations that are critical to our state's economy, cultivating a unique educational-based experience, and fostering the next generation of California leaders.

SESSION DETAILS

1) Transportation and Trade (Saturday, January 26)

Young Senators will tour and interact with leaders of the Port of Long Beach and LAX airport to learn about both the movement of goods and people.

2) Education (Saturday, February 23)

Young Senators will tour the University of Southern California (USC) and LA Trade Tech to learn about higher education's role in our local communities and state's economy.

3) Law and Society (Saturday, March 23)

Young Senators will tour Men's Central Jail, the Los Angeles County Sheriffs training academy, and a federal court to learn about the justice system, constitutionality and the basis for rule of law.

4) Health Care (Saturday, April 13)

Young Senators will tour the Children's Hospital of Los Angeles and a community health clinic to learn about public health and different access to care.

5) Government and the Legislative Process (Thursday, May 16)

Young Senators will travel to Sacramento, tour the State Capitol and interact with legislators to learn about governance and the legislative process.

6) Information Technology/Social Media (Friday, May 17)

Young Senators will travel to the Silicon Valley to tour the headquarters of Facebook and Google. The tours will demonstrate California's global leadership in the IT fields.

7) Arts, Media & Entertainment (Saturday, June 15)

Young Senators will tour Warner Brothers Studio and the Music Center to learn about the film, dance and music industries.
