3 A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE  
4 CITY OF LONG BEACH AUTHORIZING THE CITY  
5 MANAGER TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT WITH LDV,  
6 INC. TO PURCHASE A MOBILE COMMAND CENTER  
7 THROUGH THEIR CONTRACT WITH HOUSTON-  
8 GALVESTON AREA COUNCIL OF GOVERNMENTS FOR A  
9 ONE-TIME PURCHASE NOT TO EXCEED \$1,318,180,  
10 INCLUDING TAXES AND FEES

12 WHEREAS, the Charter of the City of Long Beach (the "City"), Section  
13 1802, permits the City to purchase services, supplies, materials, equipment and labor  
14 with other government agencies by purchasing under their contracts on a voluntary and  
15 selective basis when authorized by resolution; and

16 WHEREAS, the City desires to purchase a mobile command center 2022  
17 Freightliner M2 106 truck chassis with a Cummins engine and Allison transmission,  
18 including all needed communication equipment, cabinets, fiberglass insulation and other  
19 accessories, to be used by the Fire Department for emergency response operations; and

20 WHEREAS, the Fleet Services Bureau of the Financial Management  
21 Department researched procurement options for mobile command response units and  
22 discovered other agencies had completed an open, fair, transparent, and competitive  
23 procurement process; and

24 WHEREAS, the City of Long Beach reviewed the cooperative agreement  
25 options and determined that the contract between HGAC and LDV, Inc. provided the best  
26 value to the City; and

27 WHEREAS, the Houston-Galveston Area Council of Governments  
28 ("HGAC") has a contract for the purchase of these special emergency vehicles, Blanket

1 Purchase Order/Contract/Agreement etc. No. AM10-20 (“Contract”); and

2 WHEREAS, the City’s participation in the HGAC Contract will facilitate the  
3 City’s ability to purchase as well as provide considerable cost benefits to the City; and

4 WHEREAS, if the City had to utilize a formal bid process rather than  
5 participate in the HGAC Contract considerably more funds would be required;

6 NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Long Beach resolves as  
7 follows:

8 Section 1. The above recitals are true and correct and are incorporated  
9 herein by this reference.

10 Section 2. The City Manager or designee is hereby authorized to enter  
11 an agreement with LDV, Inc., to purchase a mobile command center of the same type  
12 and kind identified in the HGAC Contract except as modified by mutual agreement of the  
13 City and LDV, Inc., and the purchase by the City shall be on the same terms and  
14 conditions afforded to the HGAC in an amount not to exceed One Million Three Hundred  
15 Eighteen Thousand One Hundred Eighty Dollars (\$1,318,180) including tax and shipping.

16 Section 3. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption  
17 by the City Council, and the City Clerk shall certify the vote adopting this resolution.
