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3 A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE
4 CITY OF LONG BEACH AUTHORIZING THE CITY
5 MANAGER TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT WITH T-
6 MOBILE USA, INC. TO PROVIDE MOBILE DEVICES AND
7 CELLULAR AND DATA SERVICE PLANS, ON THE SAME
8 TERMS AND CONDITIONS AFFORDED TO THE STATE OF
9 UTAH, THROUGH THE NATIONAL ASSOCIATION OF
10 STATE PROCUREMENT OFFICIALS (NASPO)
11 VALUEPOINT MASTER AGREEMENT

13 WHEREAS, the Charter of the City of Long Beach (the "City"), Section
14 1802, permits the City to purchase services, supplies, materials, equipment and labor
15 with other government agencies by purchasing under their contracts on a voluntary and
16 selective basis when authorized by resolution; and

17 WHEREAS, the City of Long Beach desires to purchase mobile devices and
18 cellular and data service plans; and

19 WHEREAS, T-Mobile USA, Inc. has an Agreement with the State of Utah,
20 Contract No. MA176-1 ("Utah Contract") through the National Association of State
21 Procurement Officials (NASPO) ValuePoint Master Agreement; and

22 WHEREAS, the City's participation in the Utah Contract will facilitate timely
23 acquisition of the mobile devices and cellular and data services plans as well as provide
24 considerable cost benefits to the City; and

25 WHEREAS, if the City had to utilize a formal bid process rather than
26 participate in the Utah Contract considerably more funds would be required;

27 NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Long Beach resolves as
28 follows:

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1 Section 1. The above recitals are true and correct and are incorporated
2 herein by this reference.

3 Section 2. The City Manager or designee is hereby authorized to enter
4 an agreement and any amendments thereto with T-Mobile USA, Inc. to provide mobile
5 devices and cellular and data service plans on substantially the same terms afforded to
6 the State of Utah, under the National Association of State Procurement Officials
7 (NASPO) ValuePoint Master Agreement, in an annual amount not to exceed Three
8 Hundred Twenty-Five Thousand Dollars (\$325,000), until the NASPO contract expires on
9 June 30, 2024, with the option to renew for as long as the NASPO contract is in effect, at
10 the discretion of the City Manager.

11 Section 3. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption
12 by the City Council, and the City Clerk shall certify the vote adopting this resolution.
