SUBJECT: Recommendation to approve expenditure not to exceed \$27,500 for the installation of not more than 11 new lights to be located in the south alley behind 2nd Street in Belmont Shore.

DISCUSSION

The Belmont Shore business community, residential community and the Long Beach Police Department have requested more adequate lighting be installed in the south alley adjacent to the businesses located on 2nd Street. After meeting with a representative from Southern California Edison (SCE), a City Capital Projects Coordinator with the Department of Public Works who is knowledgeable in this area surveyed the site at night. She concluded that in order to adequately light the alley, up to an additional 11 lights would need to be installed.

It was confirmed by SCE that the locations under consideration are properly powered and that lights could be installed. It was noted that, due to wire clearance issues, some of the arms would have to be shorter in length (3 feet) than the standard length of 6 feet.

The cost for purchase and installation is \$2,500 per unit. The estimated time for installation would be approximately 10–12 weeks after submission of the application to SCE.

RECOMMENDATION
