3 A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE
4 CITY OF LONG BEACH IN SUPPORT OF AND
5 AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE
6 DOCUMENTS TO APPLY FOR AND ACCEPT GRANT
7 FUNDING UNDER THE AMERICAN RECOVERY &
8 REINVESTMENT ACT (ARRA) FOR THE ENERGY
9 EFFICIENCY COMMUNITY BLOCK GRANT PROGRAM
10 (EECBG)

12 WHEREAS, the City of Long Beach recognizes that it is in the interest of
13 the regional, state, and national economy to stimulate the economy; create and retain
14 jobs; reduce fossil fuel emissions; and reduce total energy usage and improve energy
15 efficiency within our jurisdiction; and

16 WHEREAS, Energy Efficiency and Conservation Block Grant ("EECBG")
17 funds are available through the American Recovery & Reinvestment Act EECBG
18 Program for grants to eligible local governments for cost-effective energy efficiency
19 projects; and

20 WHEREAS, the City of Long Beach is eligible for EECBG funding under the
21 American Recovery & Reinvestment Act EECBG Program; and

22 WHEREAS, the City of Long Beach is proposing to implement the energy
23 efficiency project(s) described in Exhibit "A" in order to qualify for EECBG funds under the
24 American Recovery & Reinvestment Act;

25 NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Long Beach resolves as
26 follows:

27 Section 1. The City of Long Beach supports and authorizes the submittal
28 of the application to the American Recovery & Reinvestment Act EECBG Program for

1 funds to execute the proposed project described in Exhibit "A".

2 Section 2. The City Manager of the City of Long Beach is hereby
3 authorized and directed to apply for and accept funding through submission of an
4 application to the American Recovery & Reinvestment Act EECBG Program for funds to
5 execute the proposed project described in Exhibit "A".

6 Section 3. If recommended for funding by the U.S Department of Energy,
7 the City Council authorizes the City of Long Beach to accept a grant award up to the
8 amount of this application for Four Million Three Hundred Ninety-Seven Thousand Five
9 Hundred Dollars (\$4,397,500), and that the City Manager of the City of Long Beach is
10 hereby authorized and empowered to execute all necessary documents, contracts and
11 agreements, and amendments hereto, to implement and carry out the purposes specified
12 in the application.

13 Section 4. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption
14 by the City Council, and the City Clerk shall certify the vote adopting this resolution.



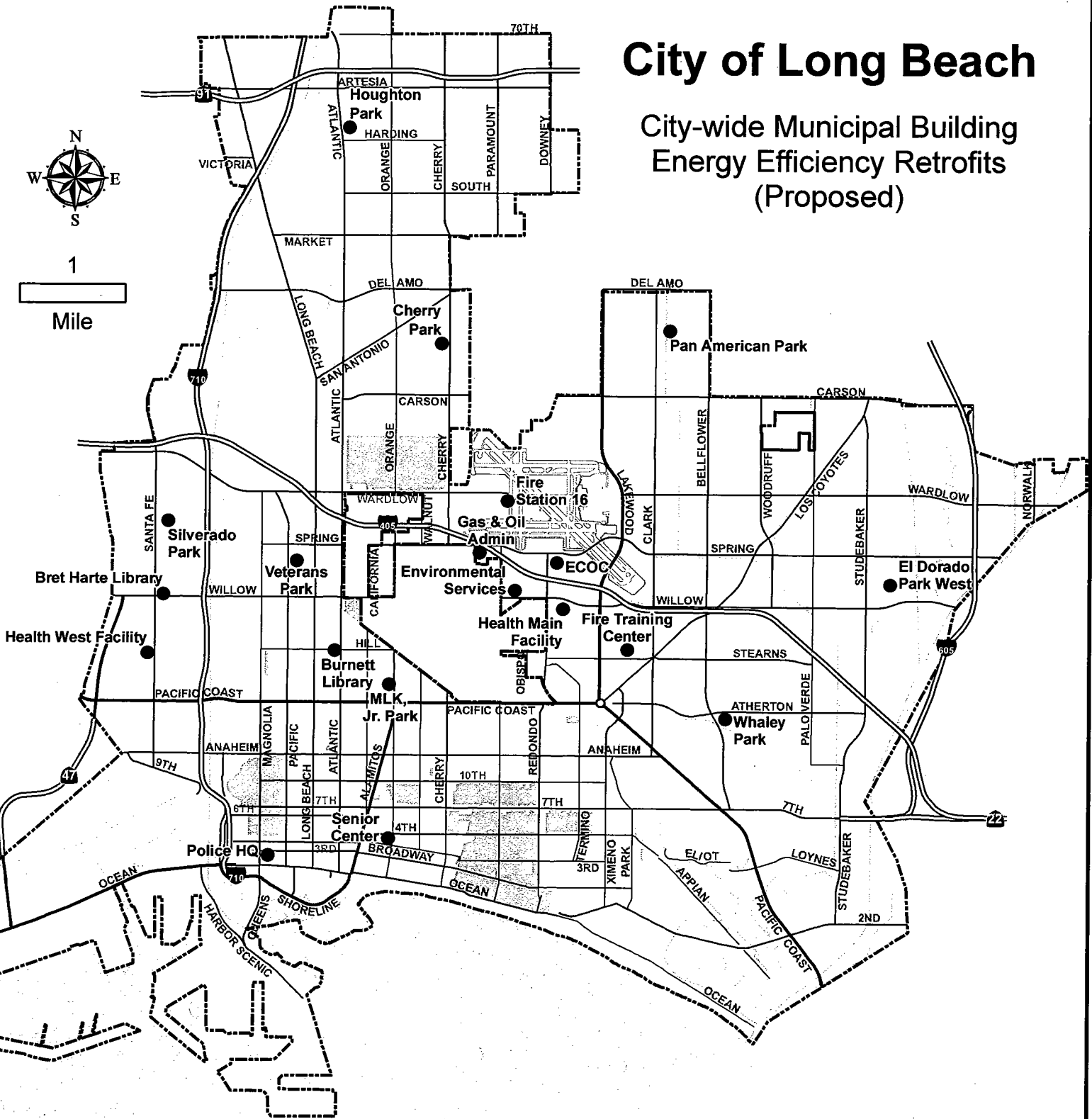
