3 A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE
4 CITY OF LONG BEACH AUTHORIZING THE CITY TO
5 EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT TO PURCHASE CELLULAR
6 BROADBAND SERVICES AND MODEMS THROUGH THE
7 CONTRACTS BETWEEN SPRINT/NEXTEL, VERIZON AND
8 AT&T WITH THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA

10 WHEREAS, the Charter of the City of Long Beach, Section 1802, permits
11 the City to participate in joint cooperative purchasing of services, supplies, materials,
12 equipment, and labor with other government agencies by purchasing under their contracts
13 on a voluntary and selective basis when authorized by resolution; and

14 WHEREAS, the City of Long Beach desires to purchase cellular broadband
15 services and modems from Sprint/Nextel, Verizon and AT&T; and

16 WHEREAS, the State of California ("State") has a contract for the purchase
17 of Sprint/Nextel services known as State of California Master Service Agreement No. 7-
18 10-70-15 ("Price Contract"); and

19 WHEREAS, the State has a contract for the purchase of Verizon services
20 known as Price Contract No. 7-10-70-16; and

21 WHEREAS, the State has a contract for the purchase of AT&T services
22 known as Price Contract No. 7-10-70-17; and

23 WHEREAS, City's participation in the Price Contracts will facilitate
24 acquisition of cellular broadband services and modems as well as provide considerable
25 cost benefits to the City; and

26 WHEREAS, if the City had to go to formal bid rather than participate in the
27 Price Contracts considerably more funds would be required;

28 NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Long Beach resolves as

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follows:

Section 1. The above recitals are true and correct and are incorporated herein by this reference.

Section 2. The City Manager of the City of Long Beach is hereby authorized to enter into an agreement with Sprint/Nextel, Verizon and AT&T for the purchase of cellular broadband services and modems as ordered by the City of Long Beach, pursuant to the Price Contracts. The purchase by the City of Long Beach shall be on the same terms and conditions afforded to the State, in a total amount not to exceed Four Hundred Eighty-Two Thousand Dollars (\$482,000.00) annually for a period of three (3) years.


Section 3. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption by the City Council, and the City Clerk shall certify the vote adopting this resolution.
