WHEREAS, recognizing that each year the President of the United States proclaims January 16th to be national "Religious Freedom Day", this day shall also be designated Religious Freedom Day by the City of Long Beach to commemorate the passage of Thomas Jefferson's Virginia Statute for Religious Freedom; and for other

WHEREAS, January 16th is the anniversary of the passage in 1786 of the Virginia Statute for Religious Freedom which statute was drafted by President Thomas Jefferson who considered it one of his greatest achievements; and

WHEREAS, the Virginia Statute for Religious Freedom ended the practice of taxing people to pay for the support of the local clergy, and it protected the civil rights of people to express their religious beliefs without suffering discrimination; and

WHEREAS, our Founding Fathers knew the importance of freedom of religion to a stable and lasting Union and the drafters of the United States Constitution relied on Jefferson's statute in establishing the First Amendment of the United States Constitution's guarantee of religious freedom; and

WHEREAS, the contributions of people of faith are and have been important to our society, and in order to maintain a pluralistic society we must work to ensure equal treatment of faith-based organizations and people of faith without religious bigotry in any form; and

WHEREAS, the City of Long Beach recognizes the importance of the annual Presidential Proclamation of the Religious Freedom Day; and
