RESOLUTION NO. RES-07-0125

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LONG BEACH AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO SUBMIT A GRANT APPLICATION TO THE CALIFORNIA DEPARTMENT OF PARKS AND RECREATION FOR FUNDING UNDER THE WILDLIFE PROTECTION ACT OF 1990 FOR THE DEVELOPMENT OF HABITAT ADJACENT TO THE WEST SAN GABRIEL RIVER PARKWAY

The City Council of the City of Long Beach resolves as follow:

WHEREAS, the people of the State of California have enacted the California Wildlife Protection Act of 1990, which provides funds to the State of California for grants to local agencies to acquire and/or develop facilities for public recreational and fish and wildlife habitat protection purposes; and

WHEREAS, the State Department of Parks and Recreation ("Department") has been delegated the responsibility for the administration of a portion of the program, including the establishment of necessary procedures for applications by local agencies; and

WHEREAS, these procedures require that the applicant certify by resolution the approval of applications before its submission to the State:

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Long Beach resolves as follows:

Section 1. That the City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to submit an application to the Department for funding under the Habitat Conservation Fund

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Program of the Act ("Program") for the development of habitat adjacent to the West San Gabriel River Parkway ("Project").

Section 2. The City Manager is hereby authorized to conduct all negotiations, accept all funds, execute and submit all documents including but not limited to applications, agreements, amendments, payment requests, and all other documents which may be necessary for the completion of the Project, and implement and administer the funds and all things related to the Project.

Section 3. The City of Long Beach certifies that it has or will have available, prior to commencement of any work on the project, the required match of funds.

Section 4. The City of Long Beach certifies that it has or will have sufficient funds to operate and maintain the project after it is completed.

Section 5. The City of Long Beach certifies that it understands the assurances and certifications in the application.

Section 6. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption by the City Council, and the City Clerk shall certify the vote adopting this resolution.
